CIRCULATION

To receive a library card, adults 18 and older must show a picture ID and proof of a current address. Children and Young Adults, 5-17, may receive a library card if accompanied by a parent or legal guardian with proper ID.

COMPUTER USE

To gain access to the Internet via TRL's network and public computers, I understand & agree to comply with the TRL Computer & Internet Use Policy, which is available in its entirety upon request. Individuals choosing to use library public computers for Internet access waive the right to any claim against the Tombigbee Regional Library, its member libraries, its employees, trustees, & agents arising from Internet use.

As a parent/guardian of a minor child named on this card, I understand that library public computers are filtered in compliance with CIPA regulations, but some content may bypass the best filters. I understand that a responsible adult must accompany all children ages 12 & under visiting the library during their visit. I accept responsibility and allow my child, age 12-17, to use library computers and have Internet access independently.
